

## A SHORT WORD

Prayer supernaturally changes things in the heavenlies that brings about change or births things on the earth. James 5:17-18 "The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much. Elijah was a man with a nature like ours, and he prayed earnestly that it would not rain; and it did not rain on the land for three years and six months. And he prayed again and the heavens gave rain, and the earth produced its fruit."

In a time when our nation is on a crash trajectory for destruction, let God's people pray and stand up boldly for the cause of truth and liberty. Let's consider the prophet Elijah and how the prayer of just one man changed the course of history.

In another passage Elijah prayed this prayer: "... O God, God of Abraham, Issac, and Israel, make it known right now that you are God in Israel, that I am your servant, and that I'm doing what I'm doing under your orders. Answer me, God; O answer me and reveal to this people that you are God, the true God, and that you are giving these people another chance at repentance." Immediately the fire of God fell and burned up the offering, the wood, the stones, the dirt, and even the water in the trench. All the people saw it happen and fell on their faces in awed worship, exclaiming, "God is the true God! God is the true God!" Elijah told them, "Grab the Baal prophets! Don't let one get away!" They grabbed them. Elijah had them taken down to the Brook Kishon and they massacred the lot. 1 Kings 18:36-40

Just think how the prayer and courage of one man changed the course of history, how the prayers of a few righteous men and women can change the course of our nation!
